

# “Gods in the Marketplace”

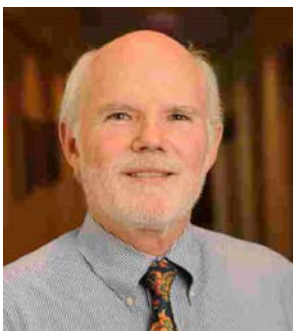
Who Do We Worship Monday through Friday?
